- **9.** Be willing to undertake any further training that may be seen as necessary to further your knowledge and to become more effective as an employee.
- **10.** Have a good knowledge of all Health & Safety aspects, and the ability to take a lead role in ensuring that policies and procedure are adhered to.
- **11.** Have a clear knowledge of equal opportunities, with the willingness to work in accordance to the equal opportunity policies of both HARP and Southend Borough Council.
